

## **Jemima Sprowls Clark**

Jemima Sprowls, wife of Robert Clark, died at her home near Good Intent, at half past five o'clock, Friday evening March 6, 1908 of tuberculosis, aged 52 years, six months and 8 days. The funeral service was held on Sunday, the interment being in West Finley cemetery. She was a daughter of the late Henry and Mary Stollar Sprowls and was born August 15, 1855. Nine brothers and sisters survive: Clinton C. Sprowls of Jefferson, George W. Sprowls, Riley Sprowls, Morgan E. Sprowls, Daniel Sprowls, and Miss Elmira Sprowls, of West Finley, Jeannette, wife of Junius Scott, of East Finley, Margaret, wife of J. J. Smith, of Wheeling.

The deceased was married in 1886 to Robert Clark, who survives with no children. At the age of fifteen she united with the Windy Gap Church, remaining a faithful member throughout life. Her paster, Rev. G. W. Hawley conducted the funeral service.
