2. Dewey Otis Harris married Mabel [Ayres] , both Duncan Falls cemetery Muskingum Co. Ohio

3. Basil Finley Harris married Delores [Waxler]both Duncan Falls cemetery Muskingum Co. Ohio

4. Landon McGee Harris married Olive Blanche [Ayres] and Mary Hoppstetter all three Duncan Falls
Cemetery, Muskingum Co. Ohio--- Olive Ayres and Mabel Ayres were sisters.

5. Cecil Vernon Harris died age 20 or 21 not married buried Greenwood Cemetery in Arch Section just
as you go through the gate on the right side but there is no stone.

6. Clayton Neal Harris not married, buried Greelawn Cemetery in Columbus Ohio. No stone but have
photo of where his grave is located.

7. William Curtis Harris married Gladys Noland /Nolan both buried Greenwood Cemetery Zanesville,
Ohio no grave stone. Both buried Charity section

8. Earl Francis Harris married Helen Marie Banfield he is buried in Holland he died during war. He has a
grave marker in Duncan Falls cemetery Muskingum Co., Ohio but he is not buried there ,also a stone
for his son Ronald Harris but he is actually buried in Calif where he died. Helen Marie is buried next to
her second husband Charles Blaine Eddeblute and one of their children Stephen. Earl and Ronalds
stones are right next to Helens and the other two.

9. Charles Edward Harris who was the oldest of the Harris sons and my paternal Grandfather, married
Minnie [Osborn]both buried Greenwood Cemetery. Zanesville, Ohio. Grave stone on the left of them
is their son Raymond Harris [my father] and other side of him is his brother Loren Harris who died
age 3 .

Burnis was called Burn by family, Dewey was always known as Ottie, , Clayton was always known as
Neal and is such in his obituary, he died in Columbus Ohio buried there.
